What is now a hostel was, for almost a century, a hotel for pioneers. The hostel is well situated for nature enthusiasts who wish to explore the vast Algonquin Park. Winter and summer alike, your hosts will be more than happy to help you organize daytrips in the area.

### Getting there by public transportation

*By bus:* The bus drops you off right in front of the hostel. Three buses per week from both Toronto and Ottawa.

**Prix :** *Shared rooms:* From \$18 for members, \$21 for non-members.

*Private rooms: Single room* – \$26 for members, \$30 for non-members.

*Double room* – \$45 for members, \$49 for non-members.

**On-site services:** Kitchen, bar, terrace, pool table, satellite TV, laundry, mountain bike rentals, canoe and kayak expeditions, shuttle to Algonquin Provincial Park.

**Amenities for families:** Discount rates depending on the number and age of children.

Algonquin Park boasts more than 770,000 hectares of dense, unpopulated forests, pristine lakes, deep gorges, and imposing plateaus. It's hiker heaven: 22 different trails criss-cross the park, for a total of 200 km! The Park is also the undisputed kingdom of bears, wolves, moose, and deer and a haven for countless loons, beavers, and raccoons.
